



2024 Annual Accessibility Status Report

This Accessibility Status Report is the annual update on the progress of the measures taken to improve accessibility and implement the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (AODA) and the Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation (Ontario Regulation 191/11).

This Status Report includes the accessibility initiatives that were completed to implement the strategies outlined in the City of Clarence-Rockland's Multi-Year Accessibility Plan.

The purpose of this Status Report is to make the public aware of the City of Clarence-Rockland's progress with regards to the Multi-Year Accessibility Plan.

The Accessibility Advisory Committee played an active role in assessing municipal event accessibility, expanding engagement through awareness initiatives, and contributing to accessibility planning across departments. The Committee supported the City's ongoing inclusion efforts by providing strategic recommendations and participating directly in accessibility-focused outreach.

Key Accomplishments Summary:

- Reviewed and provided input on the Municipal Building Assessment.
- Identified barriers and recommended improvements for the Rockland Community Garden – Access for All Project, including parking, pathways, and grade concerns.
- Conducted accessibility reviews of Canada Day and other municipal events, and reported accessibility issues, and supported the creation of an accessibility checklist for municipal programs and event planners.
- Raised concerns and encouraged the development and review of accessible document formats.
- Reviewed and provided input on the 2024-2028 Multi-Year Accessibility Plan.
