It is the responsibility of each Fire Chief or designate to determine if the student meets the prerequisite to be eligible to apply for the course. If the student has not completed the prerequisite course through the Ontario Fire College or through Grandfathering, but rather through another agency, pre-service training or through in-house training, a copy of the certificate with IFSAC / ProBoard seal must be sent with the application form as proof of prerequisite when submitting application. If the student has no record

of the prerequisite and nothing is provided, we will notify you to follow up with the fire department that has submitted the application
